Former Councillor Mike Little Elected NVDPL Board Chair

North Vancouver – The 2017 North Vancouver District Public Library Board (NVDPL) is pleased to announce the appointment of a new Board Chair and Vice Chair. Mike Little, a former District of North Vancouver Councillor, and Linda Munro, a public relations professional, were appointed to the roles of Board Chair and Vice Chair, respectively, at the January 26 inaugural meeting of the Board. Little and Munro will guide the Board throughout 2017 as the Library works towards achieving NVDPL's Mission of Connecting Community, Sharing Knowledge, and Inspiring Stories; and both Chair and Vice Chair are keen to achieve the goals outlined in the newly implemented Strategic Plan 2017-2019.

Mike Little is a known North Vancouver local, who has committed a significant portion of his life to volunteer efforts in our community. Little's involvement in community initiatives includes serving as a District of North Vancouver Councillor for nine years, being a Director of Transportation for the 2015 North Vancouver 55+ BC Games Society, undertaking the role of Executive Board Chair for the North Shore Emergency Management Office, and volunteering as a Commissioner for the North Vancouver Museum and Archives, as well as a Commissioner for the North Vancouver Heritage Commission. Mike Little is looking forward to nurturing relationships with community partners and local organizations, as well as making the best use of NVDPL facilities.

Linda Munro, the returning Vice Chair, is a long-time Lynn Valley resident and an admitted frequent user of the Library. Her resume boasts local and international experience in journalism, public relations, and corporate communications. Linda's community involvement experience includes serving as a board member for the Capilano Community Services Society and as President of Lynn Valley Parent Participation Preschool. In addition to the NVDPL Board, she is also a volunteer treasurer for the Girl Guides of Canada and a member of the Parent Advisory Committee at Ross Road School.

The nine member NVDPL Board also includes returning Board Members Mark Jefferson, Kristine Mactaggart-Wright, Allison Rzen, and Phil Webber, and welcomes two new trustees: Lara Greguric and Colleen Macmillan. District of North Vancouver Councillor Jim Hanson is re-appointed as the Council Representative, under the terms of the British Columbia Library Act.
