North Vancouver District Public Library is a community-focused Library serving almost 90,000 residents in the District of North Vancouver at three NVDPL locations. We are proud to support a culture of learning and a love of reading in our diverse community, and our unique and innovative approach to programming complements our comprehensive collection and growing digital resource library. A refreshed strategic plan is inspiring new service initiatives, and our vision is to shape the District of North Vancouver's future by inspiring learning, discovery, creativity, and collaboration in local residents.

NVDPL is seeking seven Student Librarians to work 5-hour shifts on Sundays. Student Librarians will be required to work at any of our three locations, and have on-call flexibility, as there may be opportunities for other shifts. Reporting to the Manager of Community Connections, this position will focus on the delivery of reference and reader's advisory service to the full range of library users. Librarianship at our Library requires a commitment to understanding and responding to community needs and a collaborative approach to delivering services. The work includes:

- Providing reference and reader's advisory services
- Providing digital support for patrons using their own devices and library computers
- Basic troubleshooting of library equipment, such as printers, photocopiers, scanners
- Other branch tasks, including weeding, displays, selections for Home Services, etc.

A professional librarian will be available for assisting with, and providing direction on complex questions or situations.

Qualifications include graduation from a recognized university and partial completion of a master degree program in librarianship from an accredited library school. You must have knowledge of the practices and principles of librarianship and have completed course work in the areas of reference services, reader's advisory, and programming or informational instruction. Our ideal candidates must be able to work both independently and as part of a team.

The hourly rate for this unionized position is \$25.61 (2015 rate) plus 12% in lieu of benefits.
