## **Peace Bus Delegates at North Vancouver District Public Library**

NORTH Vancouver, BC— Children’s International Summer Village (CISV) Peace Bus volunteers are scheduled to arrive in Vancouver, as part of their 39 day trek across Canada, on Thursday, June 30. As part of their visit to Vancouver, the delegates will volunteer at the North Vancouver District Public Library and become junior librarians for the day! Their summer-long journey started on June 25 in Victoria, BC.

Peace Bus youth will volunteer at all three North Vancouver District Public Libraries on Thursday, June 30 to help with Summer Reading Club sign-ups, assist with Canada Day crafts, and participate as junior librarians celebrating the start of summer with local kids.

On Friday, July 1, the Peace Bus delegates will be at the Canada Day celebrations at Waterfront Park, signing up kids for Summer Reading Club for both the District and City Libraries. With their help, the North Vancouver District Public Library hopes to make this the best Summer Reading Club ever—and we already have over 1700 children registered!

The CISV organization, founded on the principal of “building global friendship”, is an organization which cooperates with over 70 global associations and works to run educational programs for youth across the world. Each year the CISV organization operates two Peace Bus journeys across Canada: one eastbound and one westbound. The youth selected to participate in the program travel across the country meeting people, volunteering in host cities, and promote values of diversity, human rights, sustainability and conflict resolution, therefore promoting PEACE.
